

Content

A combined course which explores the subjects of Fine Art, Textiles, Digital Art and 3D Design. During this course you will learn about art, craft and design; how to use various materials and techniques to be creative and make your own works of art.

You will gain essential skills in drawing, painting, printing, mixed media, photography, textiles, collage, ceramics and 3D making. You will learn about a range of artists' work and you will work in their style. In year 10 you explore all the areas of Art, Craft & Design. In year 11 you will then develop your skills in a single area (Art, Craft or Design) as a specialism.

Assessment

- 60% coursework / controlled assessment
- 40% examination

Facilities and Equipment used

- You will have access to a range of art and design materials. Through experimentation you will explore a range of techniques, all linked to the artists and designers investigated.
- Example materials: Paint, clay, pencils, wire, print tools, oil pastels.
