Music Technology

The Stoke Damerel Music Department in 2022-23 will offer students a chance to complete the RSL, Rock School Level 2 qualification in Music Performance/Technology, which aims to run alongside the music-specific qualification also offered at Key Stage 4.

Music students will complete three units over years 10 and 11.

Students will complete one core unit:

- Unit 201ta: Music Knowledge Development (internally assessed)

Students will also complete an externally assessed core unit:

- Unit 203ta: Music Sequencing and Production

Finally, for the optional internally assessed unit students can choose from:

- Unit 206ta: Sound Recording
- Unit 207ta: Using a DAW (Digital Audio Workstation)

The above units will give students the opportunity to learn about and develop their understanding of different musical styles through the ages, to hone their music sequencing skills and to explore the music department's digital audio workstations. This is a new course offered by Stoke Damerel Community College, offering students the chance to be among the first to work with new technologies installed in the music department.

If you pick music technology as one of your options you can therefore expect a course that offers new technologies and software, with focus on developing industry-ready students who enjoy the chance to create music in a modern, inspiring environment.
