1 mark = GIVE/STATE/IDENTIFY - 1 mark

1 or 2 marks = MULTIPLE CHOICE QUESTIONS - Ensure a cross is put clearly in the appropriate box

3 marks - assessing knowledge and understanding only - **No context** required - Need to use **2 connectives** – no full stop until end of sentence.
(6 explain questions per paper – 20% of the marks for each paper)

6 marks - DISCUSS - assessing understanding and analysis only - **No context**

MUST HAVE 5 CONNECTIVES IN THE ANSWER

1 point made with 4 connectives

OR

2 points – one with 3 connectives and one with 2 connectives

2 points do not need to be an advantage and a disadvantage, just 2 relevant points

Found in Sections B and C

2 marks - OUTLINE - you need to make **one point** and **develop** it with context - **Use 1 connective to explain the point – how why**

Key connectives: which means....., because....., therefore.....

6 marks - ANALYSE - SAME STRUCTURE AS A DISCUSS ANSWER – BUT MUST BE IN CONTEXT OF THE CASE STUDY

Ideally the points should be taken from the extract,

The interconnected strands should refer to the context throughout and demonstrate a logical chain of reasoning

Key connectives: however..., therefore..., is important because..., is more/less important because..., the consequence of this...

9 marks - JUSTIFY - you will ALWAYS have two options to choose from - MUST BE in CONTEXT OF THE BUSINESS case study

Make a decision at the start as to which option you believe is the best for the business in its current situation (keep this in mind)

No definition needed

Paragraph 1: Positive of the option you have chosen explained with connectives in context

Paragraph 2: Another positive of the option that has been chosen explained with connectives in context

Paragraph 3: A negative to the option you have chosen explained with connectives in context

Paragraph 4 - provide a conclusion why you have chosen the option with discussing the short term and long term in context

12 marks - EVALUATE - MUST USE THE SAME TECHNIQUE AS JUSTIFY.

DIFFERENCE IS THE TYPE OF QUESTION – YOU HAVE TO MAKE A DECISION ABOUT THE CHOICES THE BUSINESS MAKES
