Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to invite you to attend our Virtual Year 12 subject specific Parents' Evening on Tuesday 13th July 2021. During the evening you will have an opportunity to discuss how your child is currently progressing across their subjects, getting individual feedback from subject teachers reflecting on the mock exams sat during the last few weeks. This event is a key date as we look towards Year 13, and ensure that you understand how to best support your son/daughter during Year 13 and help prepare them for next year's summer exams.

Appointments are available from 3.45pm until 6.15pm and it will give you an opportunity to meet your son/daughter's subject teacher virtually. From 9am Tuesday 6th July, you will be able to book your appointments through our website. The booking system will close at 3pm on Monday 12th January.

- For each subject, click on the link to join the meeting
- You will then be taken to a waiting room and admitted to your meeting by the teacher
- Please be aware that each meeting will be five minutes long and the system will end the call after the 5 minutes has elapsed (a timer will be on the screen to guide you.)
- Mobile devices, computers and laptops are all compatible.
