### **Monday Period 6**

As part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring every student is fully supported in the lead-up to their GCSE exams, we are now running the Monday P6 twilight session as well for ALL students to attend. The Monday session will focus solely on examination practice and techniques within the core and Ebacc subjects, and a full programme will be added to their google classroom. These sessions are designed to provide targeted support, improve exam technique, and develop subject-specific skills and knowledge. Where appropriate, these sessions will include '**Walking Talking Mocks**' to model effective exam techniques and build student confidence in exam conditions. This will start from **Monday 29th September until 4pm.**

### **Champions Hour**

In addition to Period 6, we are also introducing a "**Champions Hour**" from **4:00–5:00pm** on each evening. This will be an **optional study session** where students can complete additional revision, homework, or exam preparation in a supportive, focused environment. **Light refreshments** will be provided to help students stay energised.

### **BTEC Coursework**

We will actively monitor coursework completion throughout the school year and, if needed, invite students to catch-up sessions during Period 6 on Fridays to provide additional support.

We believe these additional sessions will make a significant difference in helping students achieve their full potential, and we greatly appreciate your support in encouraging regular attendance and participation.
